

Clearing for stationary infrastructure under the Local Land Services Act 2013

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Policy Statement

The aim of this policy is to clarify the distances and clearing allowed for moveable components of stationary infrastructure under the *Local Land Services Act 2013* (LLS Act).

Context

In the Western and Central Zones, the LLS Act enables clearing for rural infrastructure but this ‘...does not include any moveable component of infrastructure that extends the area of operation of infrastructure when used’ (Schedule 5A, Part 3 Cl29(2b)).

Scope

This policy applies to areas of the State to which the *LLS Act* is in effect.

Policy Position

Consistent with LLS Act clearing for rural infrastructure is limited to the stationary infrastructure and does not extend to the moveable components of irrigation systems, specifically:

- clearing is permitted for the circumference distance around a centre pivot but this clearing distance *does not* extend to the rotating arm of the centre pivot or the supporting wheels of the arms,
- clearing is permitted for the circumference distance around a centre pivot but this *does not* extend to the permanent tracks for lateral move irrigation,

Additionally, clearing for rural infrastructure does not extend to the permanent tracks used in controlled traffic farming.
